

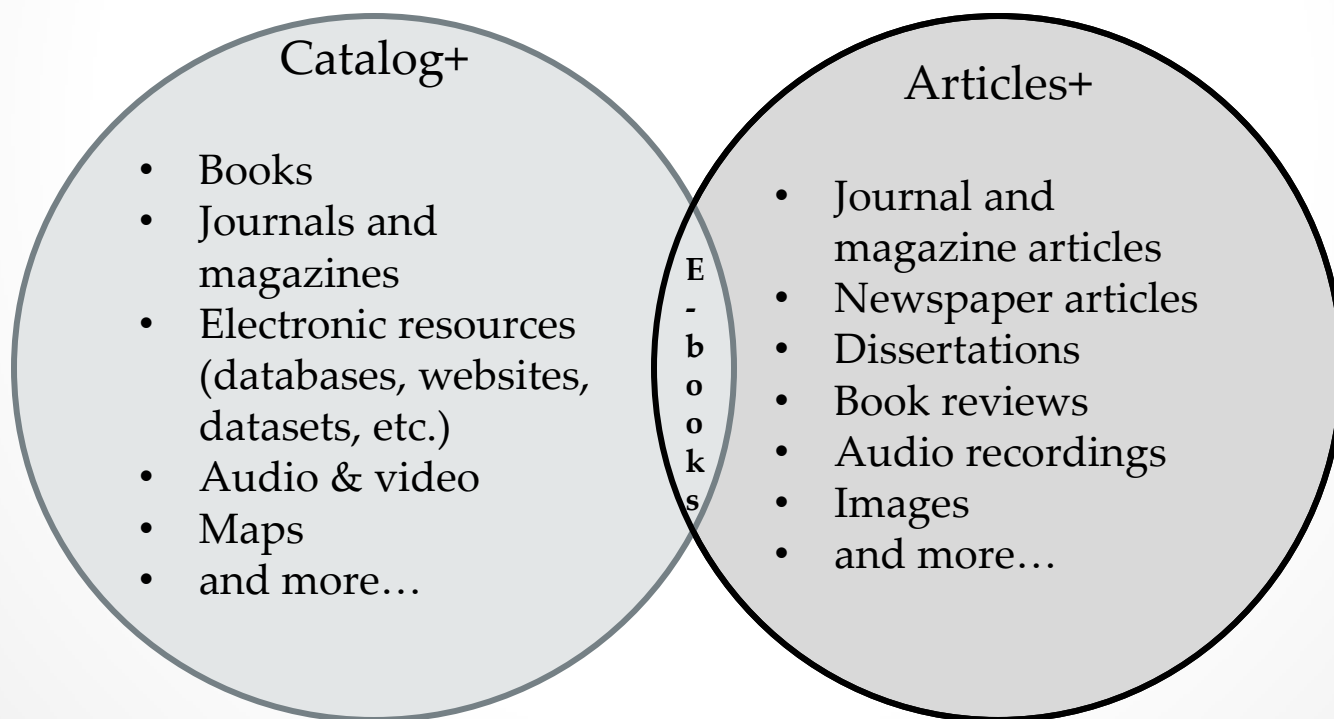

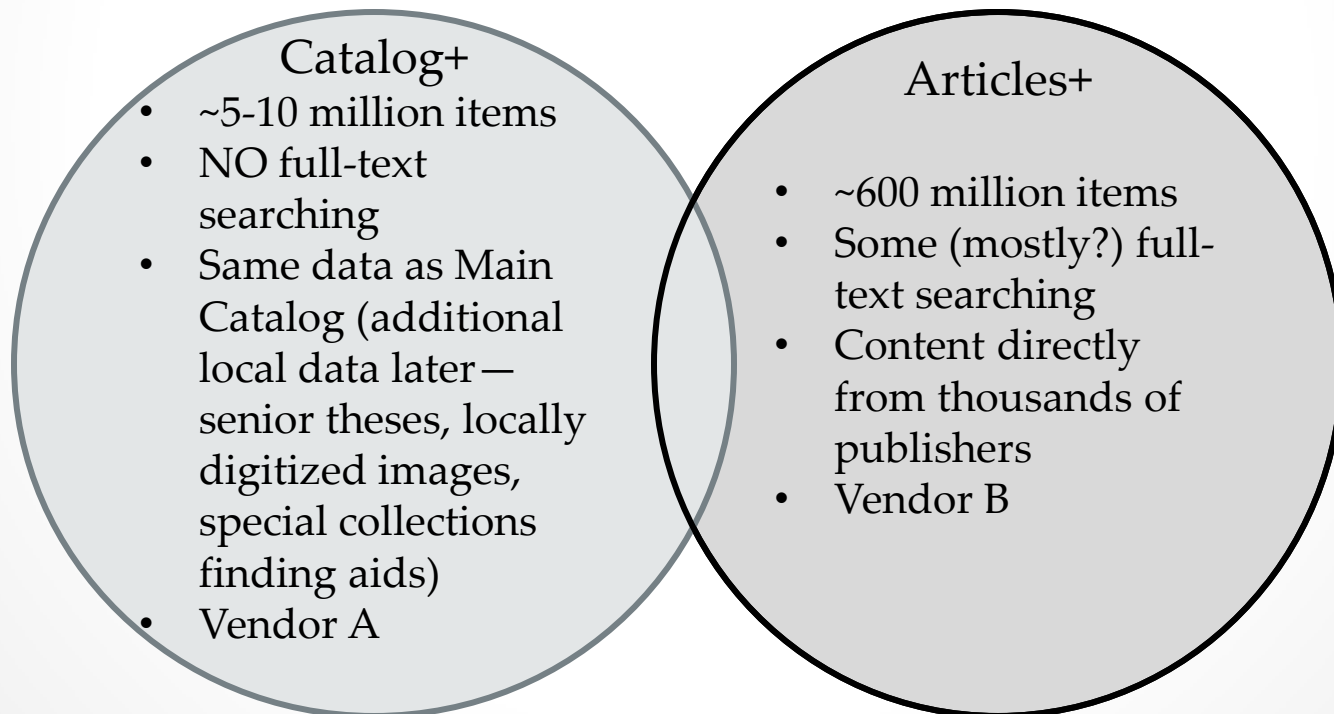

Live Demonstration

- Catalog+
 - Sample search: torture
 - Show faceted browsing
 - Created on the fly
 - item type, dates, languages, top-level subject headings (select “torture moral and ethical aspects”)
 - Sorting options
 - Individual record tabs
 - Real time availability
 - Where to find it link
 - Link to Main Catalog record
 - Link to GB (preview option on “Spirituality and the ethics of torture”)
 - Request options
 - ReCAP request (“Atlas of torture” [6th down])
 - BorrowDirect (“Understanding torture” Wisniewski [3rd down])
 - Print/email/download options
